AWARDS

Ribbons will be awarded to first through fourth place in all jump heights in all classes. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded for each qualifying run. Rosettes will be awarded for those finishing a title. Please note: Chances is pass/fail, therefore no placement ribbons will be awarded.

ADDITIONAL INFO/REQUIREMENTS

Mailing a copy of your NADAC registration card and your **dog's jump height card** will ensure that accurate trial results get submitted to NADAC. Once you have done this for our records, you will not need to do it again for future D.A.D. trials.

Check-In: Dogs checked in Saturday do not need to check in on Sunday or Monday. All dogs without a permanent height card must be measured unless running in the 20 or 20+ jump heights.

Your dog MUST be registered with NADAC to compete in this trial.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.

- **Dogs must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted. Pending numbers are no longer accepted.**
- **Current Jump Height Table, Breed Exemption List, description of classes, levels, and divisions are included in the current Exhibitors Handbook.**
- **A copy of the current Exhibitors Handbook may be downloaded free from the NADAC web site: www.nadac.com**

- Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog.
- Any dog which demonstrates aggression towards any person or any dog, whether inside the ring or outside the ring, must be excused from the agility trial. Any dog which the judge feels is not in enough control to perform all obstacles in a safe manner will be excused from the agility trial.
- This trial is open to any dog at least eighteen months of age, including purebred and non-purebred.
- No leads, collars, food, toys, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within 10 feet of the ring entrance. The only exception to this rule is leading your dog on leash to the start, then handing the leash to a ring steward.
- **All dogs must be on leash when not competing in the ring**, and must be contained unless being prepared to run.
- Safety shall always be of foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times.
- The organizing committee may refuse any entry on the basis expressly provided through NADAC rules and regulations or guidelines established by NADAC Board of Directors. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed entry into the trial.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- There shall be no refunds for entries in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the organizing committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no fees shall be refunded.
- There will be a \$20.00 service charge for any returned check. Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee.
- All crates and exercise pens are to be setup only in designated areas. Each exhibitor is responsible for cleaning up his own setup
- **Dog Identification** Use one entry form per dog)

- All dogs must show in the height class they entered in, unless measured into a higher jump height class by the judge. Dogs that measure into a higher height class will run at the end of the running order for that height class or for exhibition only in the lower height class.
- All handlers for a given class should be present at ringside at least 30 minutes prior to the start of scheduled classes for walk through and briefing. Any dog and handler not present when called will be ineligible to run.
- Any dog that fouls the ring more than once will be excused from the remainder of the competition for that day.
- RV parking at the site in the paved parking lot if you are self-contained.

THE MANAGEMENT will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

MEASURING: All dogs entered in the Proficient Category in Novice, Open, or Elite jumping 4", 8", 12", or 16" are required to be measured (except Veteran or Junior Handler dogs jumping 16"). Dogs jumping 20" and 20+ are not required to be measured. Dogs in the Skilled Categories or dogs with permanent height cards do not need to be measured. IMPORTANT. Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also, please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host club/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the files section of the NADACAgility@yahoo.com list within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. The trial results will remain on the list for at least thirty (30) days. Please accept the responsibility to review those results, and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct. You can join the www.NADACAgility@yahoo.com list and set your settings to "no mail". You'll be able to view trial results and check for any possible discrepancies without receiving list mail. If you find an error in the reporting of your dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.

Levels. Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be banked by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

Conveniences

There will not be a food vendor at the trial site. There are several nearby offsite restaurants and fast food establishments.

There are two gas stations that include mini-marts as well as a grocery store nearby.

DIRECTIONS:

Directions: From Hwy 160 East or West, go to the only traffic light in Bayfield. Turn toward Conoco to Stop sign. Turn right and then left immediately on to C.R. 521 (Buck Hwy). Continue 0.4 miles and turn on second right which is South Street. Then go 0.3 miles (curves to the left) and turn right at second entrance. Watch for signs. Please observe speed limits.

Overnight RV Parking and Tent Camping is allowed in the paved parking lot of the trial site. (NO hook-ups are available). Please note this location of camping is different than in the past. NO overnight RV camping will be permitted on Mill Street. There is construction, so please look for and follow the signs.

MOTELS and RV PARKING THAT ACCEPT DOGS:

Remember, this trial will be held on Labor Day 3-day weekend. Motels and hotels will be filling quickly, so make your reservation as soon as possible.
