THE SITE

The San Juan Basin Research Center covers 6,500 acres, five miles south of Hesperus, Colorado on Hwy.140. It was the site of Fort Lewis Military Fort, as well as Fort Lewis College until 1956. The property is leased by Colorado University from the State Land Board for research and education.

The site for the agility trial surrounds the historic library, which is slated for restoration later this year. This 3,600 acre portion of the Research Center covers a wonderful area containing cottonwoods and other indigenous trees, a small creek, lots of open space and a variety of areas to take advantage of for overnight RV or tent camping.

Potable (drinking) water is not available at this time. Exhibitors must bring their own drinking water.

Exhibitors are advised to bring shade even though there are trees.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

EXHIBITORS NEED TO BRING DRINKING WATER.**

Crating space will be allowed in the designated area only. Crates may be left overnight; however, the Durango Kennel Club and the San Juan Basin Research Center will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

A food concession will be available on the site. Various restaurants and fast food vendors are approximately 15 miles from the trial site. There is a small market at the Sinclair gas station and an upscale restaurant called the Kennebec Café. A little pricy but very good and you don't need to dress up. Located in Hesperus 5 miles from the site on Hwy 160. Saturday and Sunday brunch is between 8 a.m. and 3 p.m. Dinner is served between 5 p.m. and 9 p.m.

Overnight parking will be allowed at the trial site. Nice areas for tent camping will be available. All camping must be self-contained. Portable toilets will be available.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card/Valid yellow form and exhibitors must be able to present it prior to running their dog(s) in any class or at any time during the trial upon request whether or not they have sent a copy of such with their entry. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC ILP or PAL number. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place outdoors on a grass surface. Ring size will be 100 ft. x 100 ft. minimum.

Illegible entries and incomplete entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$25 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

RIBBONS

Ribbons will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

First Place.....	Blue
Second Place.....	Red
Third Place.....	Yellow
Fourth Place.....	White
Qualifying Score.....	Dark Green

A new title rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title. A MACH rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their MACH.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Durango Kennel Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Durango Kennel Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Durango Kennel Club or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. As such, the club will refund the entry fee paid for bitches unable to compete for this reason upon presentation of a veterinarian certificate. This certificate must be presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial or cluster of trials.

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging, if a valid copy of their jump height card was sent with their entry. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

CATALOGS

A limited number of catalogs will be available for sale at the trial site for a cost of \$5.00. Running order sheets will be available to all exhibitors at no charge.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

From Durango: Drive west on Hwy 160 towards Cortez. The intersection of Hwy 550 and Hwy 160 is by the Doubletree Hotel in Durango. Look for the sign for the Research Center. Turn left (South) onto CR140. The turn is at the Sinclair gas station/small grocery store. Go 4.7 miles (6 min.) and you will see the Fort Lewis sign, then the Four Corners Bull Test Center sign. Turn right at the 2nd entrance, you will see the Four Corners Draft Horse Assoc. sign.

From Albuquerque: Take Hwy 550 to Aztec, NM. Go all the way through town until you get to the "T" and stop light. Instead of turning right to Durango, turn left towards Farmington. You go through one light by the A&W and then cross the river. At the next light turn right onto 574 (N. Light Plant Rd.) Follow 574 about 12 miles until it dead-ends into NM170. Turn right (north) on to 170. After you cross the state line the road becomes 140. 19 miles after the state line you'll see the Four Corners Draft Horse Assoc. sign. Turn left. If you get to the Four Corners Bull Test Center sign or mile marker 20, you've gone too far.

From Farmington: West on W Broadway/US-64 W. Continue to follow US-64 W and the turn off for the LaPlata Hwy is a mile west of Farmington. Turn right onto LaPlata Hwy/NM170 going north. Road turns into 140 at the NM/CO state line. 19 miles after the state line. Turn left at the Four Corners Draft House Assoc. Sign.

From Cortez: US 160/CR789 toward Durango, turn right on to CR140. The turn is at the Sinclair gas station/small grocery store. Go 4.7 miles (6 min.) and you will see the Fort Lewis sign, then the Four Corners Bull Test Center sign. Turn right at the 2nd entrance, you will see the Four Corners Draft Horse Assoc. sign.
