

D.A.D. Training Site Parking Instructions

As you all know, we have an incredible site for our use as D.A.D. club members and students. It is our goal to remain welcome guests of our hosts, Mary and her dog Heidi.

There are a few rules that everyone must agree to in order to protect Mary's property, maintain safety for our dogs, our cars and us. As you have all noticed, parking is at a premium. In order to best serve all of you, we need to make the most of the parking that is available. If everyone follows a few procedures we should be able to accommodate all the parking needs.

Parking in the driveway within the fence

1. On Class night and big use nights, please park the first 4 cars at a right angle to the big grassy field on the right side of Mary's house. Park straight and parallel to the "dog run" so that we can fit 4 cars. It is very important that you keep your vehicles on the paved area and **do not, under any circumstances, drive on the grass.** (There are sprinkler heads in the grass positioned very close to the edge of the pavement.)

You can easily back out of the driveway. DO NOT attempt to turn around to leave. There is plenty of time to get out of your car, then hit the gate button, get back in your car and back out. Be aware that there are sprinkler heads right next to the driveway. If you try to turn around there is a good chance of hitting them. Should that happen, you will be held responsible for its replacement.

2. The next cars will park in front of the garage all the way forward so that we can fit 8 to 9 cars in the driveway.
3. **Reminder: Do not drive on the grass within the fenced area for any reason. It is not an option!**

Parking along the road, outside the fenced area

1. Along the narrow road which goes past Mary's property, there is parallel parking available for an additional 7 to 8 cars. Please park half on the road and half on the grass. (Please don't park in the grassy area any more than you have to, as there are sprinkler heads in the grass along side this road.)
2. There is No Parking from the County Road to the driveway gate and No Parking on the south side of the road which leads to the training field.
3. If you know that you must leave before the rest of the group will be leaving, park outside the fenced area in the designated area along side the road. Only use this area if you know you have to leave early.
4. On nights or days that only a small group or an individual use/s the training field, keep the right side of the driveway clear. This is the side of the garage and driveway that Mary uses.

<p>Don't forget to sign a release form. Mary and the club need to have this done before any activity on the field and equipment is to occur. Have fun, be safe and remember your actions judge all of us, not just yourself.</p>
